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

Campus Conservational Nationals (CCN) runs from April 5—25.

Throughout April we challenge you to **Flip The Switch** as we compete against colleges and universities across the nation to see who can conserve the most energy. In 2014, we competed for the first time and placed in the top 20 schools out of 109! This year we intend to place in the top 10 out of over 175 schools.

### Giant Bottle

Students for a Sustainable Future created a giant plastic bottle filled with empty plastic bottles salvaged from Missouri State's trash and recycling. With the help of Residence Life, it took only a matter of a few days to accumulate the bottles needed for this project, equivalent to the 1,700+ bottles sold on campus every day.

Come to the North Mall from now until March 30th to see this tangible display of waste on our campus!

If you want to reduce your waste, consider buying a reusable water bottle and using the 20 filtered water bottle refilling stations located around campus. If you still want to buy soft drinks, join the Reusable Cup Program made possible by SGA. Through this program you can get a red reusable cup and unlimited drink refills at the PSU for only \$39.95 semester! Subsequent semesters cost less once you have purchased the cup. These can be picked up from Grill Nation in the PSU.

### **Diversion Rate**

The numbers for 2014 are in and Missouri State University is showing a diversion rate of 42%! This means that out of all the waste produced by the university, 42% is being recycled, composted or donated. It is estimated that 75% of waste is either recyclable or compostable. We are doing much better than the national average of 33.8%, but can always improve and aim for 75%! ## Conserve Energy

- Unplug everything not in use
- Set computer monitors to sleep after 5 minutes (or less) of inactivity
- Adjust the thermostat to conserve energy

- Use a power strip: turn it off OR unplug when not in use
- Shut down computers every night
- Turn off lights in common areas when you leave
- Open the blinds during the day to use natural light
