

## Did you know?

## The Accessible Learning Institute

The Accessible Learning Institute is designed to help you identify and resolve accessibility concerns with your course materials and teaching; whether in the online environment or the physical classroom. It will be targeted toward your class and challenges you are facing in making your course accessible to all students. It will also introduce the principles of Universal Design for Learning and support in designing a course around UDL.

Faculty will receive a \$250 stipend for completing the 4 day institute. During Fall semester, faculty will work with Instructional Designers transforming their course utilizing UDL guidelines. Faculty successfully completing this process will be recognized as "UDL Experts" mentoring faculty in their college on accessible learning.
