SELECTION OF PRESENTATIONS:

All abstracts are peer- reviewed based upon the following criteria:

- ◆ Adherence and relevance to the theme: The Cutting Edge: Technology and Computer Science in Education
- ♦ Inclusion of best practice(s) with technology and computer science in schools
- ♦ Evidence of the background knowledge needed to present on the theme
- ♦ Job-embedded professional skills that focus on effective use of technology and computer science

SUBMITTING AN ABSTRACT:

- Workshop-Provide a one page summary and properly documented bibliography of the intended research based presentation
- Poster- Provide a description of the research based poster content- visual files requested but not required
- ♦ Number of Submissions—Maximum of two abstracts, either as a main presenter or co-presenter
- ♦ Use of Vendor Materials—Indicate the name of the vendor
- Use of acronyms, all CAPS (or all lower case) for names, affiliations, addresses, titles, or descriptions are not acceptable
- Presenters (workshop or poster)- Submit a brief bio, resume, or curriculum vita
