



Graduate Certificate in Dyslexia

The Graduate Certificate in Dyslexia will provide a 12-hour graduate-level program for individuals interested in understanding the complexities of working with students identified as dyslexic or those demonstrating characteristics of dyslexia. The certificate program will provide individuals with both theory and practical knowledge, including hands-on training, for working with students in their own classroom or in an intervention setting. All courses will be offered online. The Graduate Certificate in Dyslexia will be issued by Missouri State University and does not represent state or national certification in dyslexia.
