

Council for the Accreditation of Educator Preparation (CAEP) Status

From Dr. Tinkler: “MSU received notification last week that we have been granted full accreditation by CAEP for both our Initial and Advanced programs. All five CAEP standards were met at both the Initial and Advanced levels. This accreditation status is effective between Spring 2020 and Spring 2026. The next site visit will take place in Fall 2025.

We received an Area for Improvement (AFI) for the Initial programs related to standard 5.2. This AFI states: "The EPP created assessments do not meet the CAEP Evaluation Framework level of sufficiency for rubrics." AFIs indicate areas which must be improved by the time of the next accreditation visit. In the CAEP Annual Report, EPPs are required to report each year on progress made to address the AFI. The six AFIs noted on the previous NCATE review were all removed.

EPP leadership will continue to work with EPP members in the Continuous Improvement Seminars to revise EPP created assessments to meet CAEP standards.”
