Fiction Judge Ron Austin of St. Louis, Missouri, is the author of *Avery Colt Is a Snake, a Thief, a Liar,* which won the 2017 Nilsen Literary Prize.



Poetry Judge Kathy Goodkin is the author of *Sleep Paralysis* and *Crybaby Bridge*, which won the 2018 Moon City Poetry Award,
