The following activities are all free and open to the public.

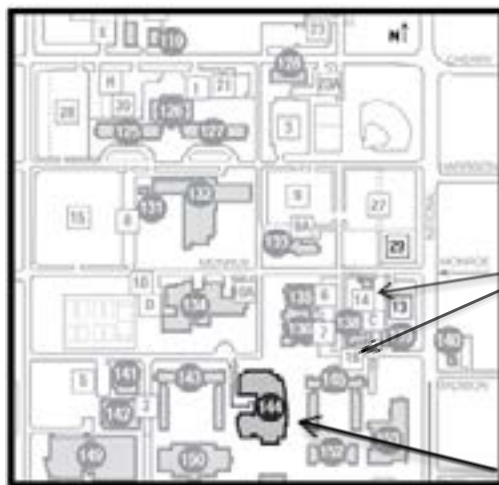
9:45 - 10:15 AM- Missouri State's Canteen
