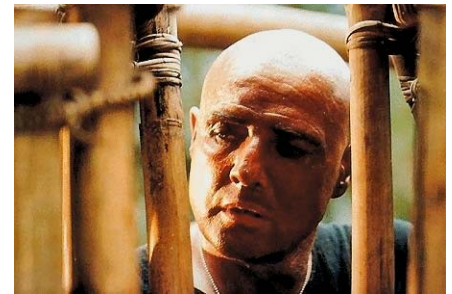
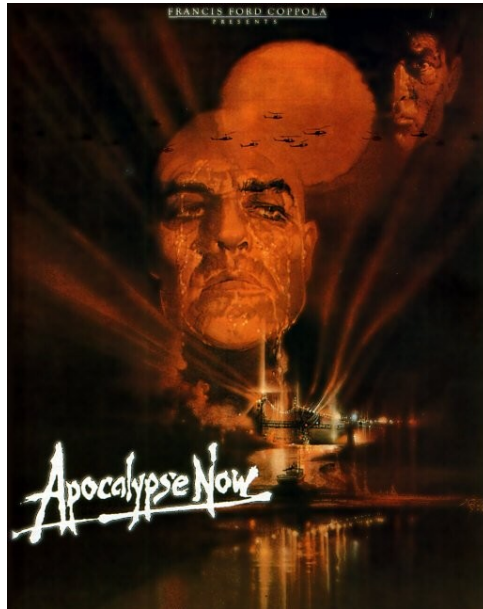

His mission is to seek out and "eliminate" a mysterious Green Beret Colonel, Walter Kurtz.
