SAI PROGRAMS FACULTY FELLOWS PROGRAM

Faculty in all disciplines are invited to apply for the 2017-18 SAI Faculty Fellows Program in Florence or Rome. The deadline is Jan. 5, 2018. If accepted, the fellowship can be arranged for four consecutive weeks during any of the following periods: June 1–July 31, 2018, Oct. 1–Nov. 30, 2018 or Feb. 1 to Mar. 31, 2018. Because SAI is an affiliate partner of Missouri State, this opportunity is available to Missouri State faculty to broaden their teaching and scholarship activities in Italy. No knowledge of the Italian language is required. The award includes international air travel and a private studio or one bedroom apartment accommodation for one month.
