## SAI PROGRAMS FACULTY FELLOWS PROGRAM

Missouri State faculty are invited to apply for the 2019/20 SAI Faculty Fellows Program in Florence or Rome, Italy. This program offers faculty the opportunity to broaden their teaching and scholarship activities through a funded month in Italy. The purpose of the Faculty Fellows Program is to foster a deeper connection between faculty from affiliate schools and Italian institutions and to provide opportunities to faculty for continuing their research and studies. The Faculty Fellow may serve as an occasional guest lecturer during the Fellowship. No knowledge of Italian language is required. The award includes international air travel, and a private studio or one bedroom apartment accommodation for four weeks in Florence or Rome. Applications for the 2019-2020 program are due January 4, 2019.
