## CONTEMPORARY CULTURE IN SCOTLAND

- Identify historical, social, and cultural events that shaped Scottish national identity and culture.
- Research Scottish cultural figures who have influenced Scottish cultural products such as art, letters, and folklore
- Explore aspects of historical and modern-day Scotland, in particular Edinburgh and the Edinburgh Festival Fringe's influence on culture and the world.



# UNITED KINGDOM

## Program Highlights

- Attend performances on the Edinburgh Festival Fringe and the Edinburgh International Festival.
- Two day trips: Glasgow (see architecture and design by Charles Rennie Macintosh) and the Scottish Highlands.
- Climb Arthur's Seat. Optional: dance classes at Dance Base, the National Dance Centre in Edinburgh.

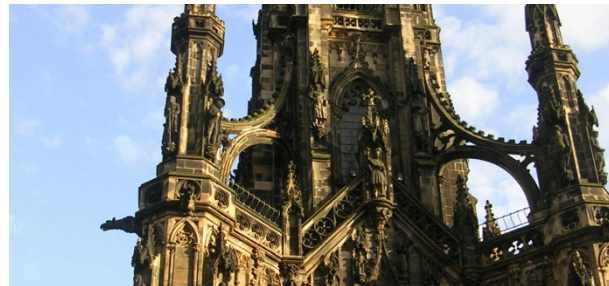




# UNITED KINGDOM

## Courses

- **IDS 297:** 3 credit hours – fulfills a **General Education Arts** requirement
- **UHC 350:** 3 credit hours – fulfills an **Honors College Cultural Competency** requirement
- These are both undergraduate courses that have no prerequisite.
- 2.75 GPA required



# UNITED KINGDOM

## Course requirements

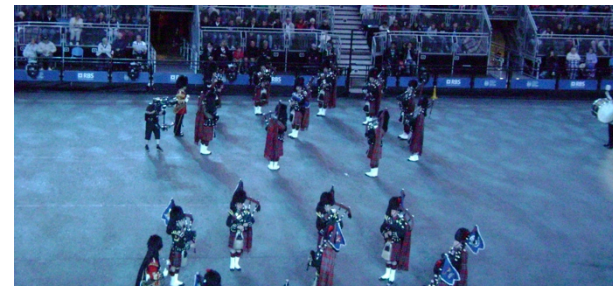
- This is an immersion course in Scottish culture and the arts
- There will be three orientation meetings during Spring semester
- Students will compile a portfolio of activities while in Scotland; analyze their experience, with emphasis on who, what, where, when, and why; submit the portfolio two weeks after returning to Springfield
- Give one informal presentation about an influential Scottish figure



# UNITED KINGDOM

## Travel component

- **You will need a valid US passport:**  
<https://travel.state.gov/content/passports/en/passports.html>
- **Leave Springfield August 6<sup>th</sup>, 2017; return August 16<sup>th</sup>, 2017**
- Stay in Edinburgh; day trips to Glasgow and the Scottish Highlands
- No visas or inoculations are necessary

## Cost

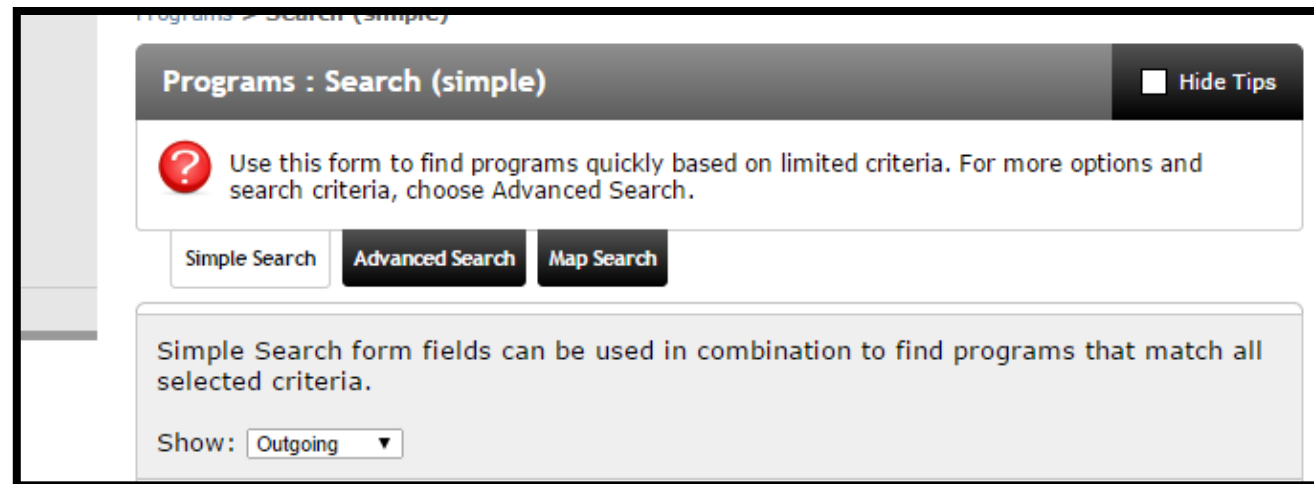
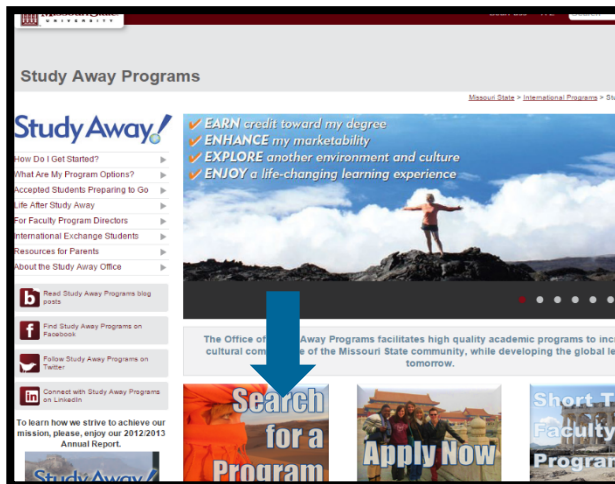
- \$2,920 – this includes:  
Round-trip airfare from Springfield, lodging, day trips to Glasgow and the Scottish Highlands, two performances, and taxi between Edinburgh airport and town.
- **NOT INCLUDED:** food, most performances and classes, tuition.



- Progress meter will display overall completion.


